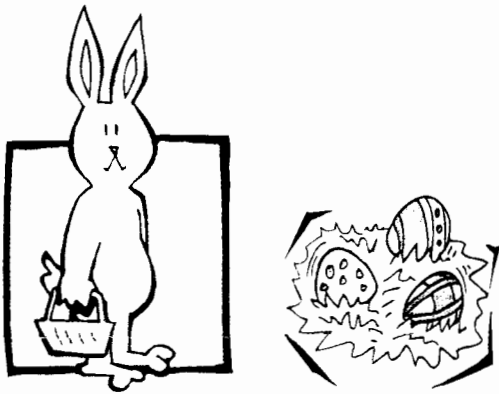

Minutes later, the rooster walks in. He spots the colored eggs, then storms out and beats up the peacock.

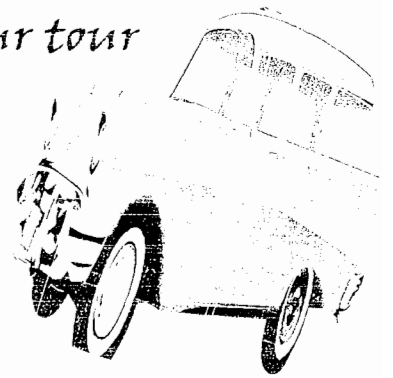


Sutter Creek Gold Mine Tour
