With a walkie-talkie you don't have to mount an antenna on your car. The range of the wlkie-talkie is almost as good as a CB radio. The FRS-GMRS walkie-talkies are available at stores like Walmart, Best Buy or Radio Shack for less than \$50 a pair.
