LICORICE SNAPS

In large bowl beat until fluffy:

3/4 cup sugar

3/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar

1 cup softened margarine

Add and blend well:

1 egg

Stir in and mix well:

2 cups all purpose flour

1 tbsp. anise seed

1 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. cloves

1/2 tsp. cinnamon

Stir in:

1/2 cup chopped pecans

Bake 375 degrees for 6 to 8 minutes or until golden brown. Immediately remove from cookie sheet. Cool completely

This recipe was given to me by Lillette Correia who was my supervisor at Merced County Child Support. She noted: These can be baked as dropped cookies. The original recipe called for dough to be divided in half and shaped into 10 inch long rolls.
